NFPA 241, Safeguarding Construction, Alternation, and Demolition Operations

The topic of this meeting comes through the eyes of the fire service in regards to the requirements and enforcement of NFPA 241, Safeguarding Construction, Alternation, and Demolition Operations. Demolition and construction operations present an increased potential for fire due to the presence of large quantities of combustible materials and debris, as well as heat and fuel sources often necessary for construction processes.

Our speaker for this meeting is Fire Lieutenant Chris Towski from the City of Cambridge Fire Department. Chris has over twenty two years in the fire service and his current position for nearly ten years has been in the Fire Prevention Office where his primary duties are to enforce State laws and codes related to Fire Prevention and Protection. He is also a Massachusetts Licensed Electrician and Construction Supervisor. He is certified in as an Emergency Medical Technician, Firefighter Levels I and II, Fire Officer Levels I and II, Fire Instructor Levels I and II, and Fire Incident Safety Officer. He has been his Department's Electrical Safety Officer for almost ten years and is not only a Technical Committee Member on NFPA 241 but serves on NFPA 18, Wetting Agents, NFPA 18A, Water Additives for Fire Control and Vapor Mitigation, NFPA 1150 for Foam Chemicals for Class A Fires and NFPA 855 for Stationary Energy Storage Systems. As if he is not busy enough, Chris is also currently the Second Vice President of the Fire Prevention Association of Massachusetts.
