Design and Installation using Specific Application Sprinkler Heads

Tyco Fire Protection Products has been an industry leader in the research and development of specific application sprinklers. While these products have been available for some time now, there remains confusion with their proper use and design due to their special listings. Our speaker for this meeting will be Kevin Maughan, Manager of Technical Services for Tyco Fire Protection Products. Kevin will be discussing the use and application of several specific application products such as window sprinklers and how they can be used to obtain up to a two hour fire rating equivalency at glazed wall assemblies, attic sprinklers and combustible concealed space sprinklers. This discussion will focus on the proper use of these products as well as the more common listing and design related questions that have been received by Kevin for these products over the years. This is a unique opportunity to ask any questions you may have to get answers and a better understanding about using these non-standard sprinkler technologies.

For those of you that may not know Kevin, he is the Manager of Technical Services; Automatic Fire Protection, for Tyco Fire Protection Products Research and Development located in Cranston, Rhode Island. Kevin spent thirteen years in the Contracting side of the business as a Sprinkler Designer and Design Manager before being employed by Central Sprinkler Company in 1994 as a Technical Services Representative and later as the Director of Technical Services. He has previously been Manager of Product Applications with Tyco. Kevin assisted in the development of and instructs at Tyco Fire Protection Products training seminars held at the Tyco Research and Development Center in Cranston, Rhode Island. He has given numerous lectures and technical presentations on "New Technologies" for fire sprinkler professionals across the country. He is a committee member for NFPA Standards 13, 14, 24 and 80. He is NICET Certified, serves as an alternate member on the NFSA Engineering and Standards Committee and he also sits on the American Fire Sprinkler Associations Technical Advisory Committee.
