PREPARING FOR A FIRE PUMP ACCEPTANCE TEST

The title of this presentation says it all. There is a lot that goes into performing a fire pump acceptance test or just a yearly test correctly. It will be great to hear how to accomplish that from two of our own local “experts” on the topic of fire pumps.

Our speakers for this meeting are Rick Dumont and Tom Quinn. Both well known to us all. Rick is a co-founder of Rosemont Engineering, Inc., the New England Representative for Firetrol; a manufacturer of fire pump controllers. At Rosemont, Rick has worked with fire pump controllers for over 25 years.
