DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND COORDINATION REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL CPVC INSTALLATION

CPVC pipe and fittings are heavily utilized in the installation of fire sprinkler systems. The main reason is low cost, relatively low failure rate, and ease of installation. However, there are occasional failures in systems utilizing CPVC pipe and fittings. Failures are caused by a number of factors including: improper installation, manufacturing defects in pipes and fittings and contamination of CPVC by incompatible chemicals. This presents liability issues for specifying engineers as well as installing contractors.
