USING NITROGEN GENERATORS TO PROTECT DRY PIPE AND PRE-ACTION SYSTEMS FROM CORROSION

Shortly after graduation he took a warehouse position at Boston Pipe & Fittings Company and worked his way up to being a distributor outside salesman. There he was introduced to and learned about fire protection from one of the most passionate fire sprinkler salesmen in our area, Mr. RonLemiere.

During that time an employment opportunity in the fire protection division of Anvil International presented itself.
