## The new UL Listed Antifreeze that Johnson Controls (Tyco) named Liquid Freeze Protection (LFP™) and a review of the new DV-5A Deluge and Preaction valve.

## THE PRESENTATION:

The first half of the presentation will review the new UL Listed Antifreeze that Johnson Controls (Tyco) has recently released named Liquid Freeze Protection (LFP<sup>TM</sup>). LFP<sup>TM</sup> is listed to - 10°F, 150°F and is listed for NFPA 13, 13R and 13D fire sprinkler systems. LFP<sup>TM</sup> is the only UL listed antifreeze on the market for fire sprinkler systems. The second half of the presentation will review the new DV-5A Deluge and Preaction valve that Johnson Controls (Tyco) released last month. The new DV-5A valve assembly will replace the previous DV-5 valve assembly and is UL, ULC and FM approved. The new DV-5A valve has a higher-pressure rating (300 psi), a lower pressure drop, a smaller footprint, is built with a modular trim concept, has one moving part and has an external reset.
